It all began at the time of the dotcom bubble with a single event format. **The Hamburg online captains' meeting** was "the" industry get-together for the young digital media scene. By the time the bubble burst, the event had grown to an incredible 1,200 participants. When the Cap San Diego museum ship in Hamburg harbor no longer offered enough space, we moved to the old Kaispeicher A, the base of today's Elbphilharmonie, which rises out of the old warehouse with a glass structure reminiscent of sails.

Founded in the summer of 1997, we celebrated our **25th Anniversary** in fall 2022 with **Future Summit & Anniversary Party** again on our ship, the **Cap San Diego**. At our anniversary conference, we brought together innovators, thought leaders and heroes of our time to define a new start together.

We want to use the new momentum and experience of the last 25 years to redefine ourselves and make our contribution to a better future society.

We invite the representatives of new member companies to a **Welcome on Board Dinner** and introduce the companies to the network with a video.

Under the heading "Female Leadership", Hamburg@work's **Women's Club** offers female specialists and managers a platform where they can network and exchange ideas, as well as expand and share their specialist knowledge. Our Women's Club was founded in 2016 on the initiative of Petra Carlsen, owner of ChangeManufaktur, and other female managers from the network

As part of **Diversity@work**, we also talk about how companies can strengthen their resilience, become more innovative and efficient and thus successfully face the constant change in these times.

Female leadership and **diversity** are two very important pillars for us. We present successful concepts and measures from people and companies on these topics, allow experts to have their say and engage in discussions with our member companies.

Since fall 2022, we have been offering our C-level members the **Executive Leadership Circle**, a confidential network for experienced leaders who share the common goal of learning from each other and developing themselves further. By sharing experiences and specialist topics - in a protected space - we create professional and personal added value for all participants, including top professional coaching. All with the professional expertise of Melanie Kuhlmann, a top executive coach who has been with Hamburg@work since our early years. The business administration graduate is a soft skills coach, agile coach trainer and certified motivational analysis expert.

AI.HAMBURG is an initiative initiated by Smaato founders Petra Vorsteher & Ragnar Kruse and launched together with Hamburg@work and municipal partners. Our common goal is to accelerate the adaptation of artificial intelligence in companies and start-ups, to promote training and further education and to build a leading ecosystem for the application of artificial intelligence.

Our **Hamburg IT Strategy Days** have long since developed into a leading national congress for CIOs and have reaffirmed their pioneering role as Germany's preferred conference for top IT decision-makers from user companies every February since 2002. Since 2022, we have supplemented the program with a multi-day **IT Strategy Days**





Masterclass Summit in the summer. All events are organized in partnership with Computerwoche, CIO Magazin and Faktor 3 Live.

Even the exclusively virtual opportunities of 2021 and 2022 led to a record result under the extraordinary conditions, with more than 1,200 CIOs and digital managers taking part in the more than 120 varied formats and many digital networking opportunities.

As the target group of the IT Strategy Days are exclusively CIOs and other IT decisionmakers from companies that use IT, only **member companies** with a Premium Plus membership have **the exclusive privilege** of purchasing one of the supplier tickets that are otherwise not available on the market.

Hamburg@work also utilizes the enormous potential of the conference beyond the IT Strategy Days within the framework of the **IT Executive Club**. Together with IT users based in the metropolitan region, Hamburg@work has the IT Executive Club, a regional platform that strengthens and promotes exchange and networking among IT managers. Since January 2021, the IT Executive Club e.V. has been set up as a legally independent division within the Hamburg@work network.

- The Welcome on Board Dinner is our own series of events. New members of Hamburg@work are welcomed at the invitation of the Executive Board and introduced to the network. Lately, it has even been an exclusive cooking event where we put on our aprons and prepare a delicious course meal together. Together with Chef de Cuisine Sajoscha Hamann, we enjoy an interactive cooking experience. With this format, we offer an event that connects people through cooking and eating together and promises a maximum experience.
- Our live classic among Hamburg@work's events is the openDeck. Around 100 to 200 Hamburg@work members and guests meet regularly after work to make new contacts and deepen existing ones, as well as to discuss the latest digital topics during a varied program.
- At the BusinessBreakfast, you can regularly expect exciting specialist presentations lasting around 45 minutes, intensive technical discussions with the speakers, plenty of time for networking and a richly laid breakfast table.
- At CaptainsTalk, 15 to 20 heads of the digital economy are brought together at one table as part of a business lunch to discuss current trend topics. Inspiring keynote speeches by experts provide a good basis for stimulating discussions. In the small circle of participants, specific questions are asked, in-depth discussions are held and, ideally, new business relationships are forged.
- The Message in a Bottle event series is not much different. Here, Hamburg@work offers another exclusive networking event in a special setting. Experience a wine tasting in a completely different way: While you get to know exquisite wines from different growing regions presented by a sommelier, you have the opportunity to exchange professional and personal ideas in a small group.





- The DinnerTalk is an upscale evening event that you can organize yourself. It is the perfect forum to present your own topics, make new contacts and present your company to your network.
- The DISRUPT NOW! Future Summit sheds light on the effects of disruptive developments on working life, companies, society and politics and gives you an insight into the technologies of the future that will cause a sensation in the coming years.
- The Hamburg@work on Tour event format gives members and guests a rare glimpse behind the scenes of selected member companies from the digital economy.
- Our Learning Journeys are true traveling conferences. You have to experience new things in order to understand them. In many places, the trends of tomorrow are emerging right now, new technologies are being developed and innovations are being implemented.
- North by Northwest is an example of constantly new formats. In this case, we have merged two established event formats into a joint event. The Düsseldorf Digitalk met the Hamburg onlineTalk. Three to four discussion partners discussed a common topic simultaneously in a Hamburg and a Düsseldorf TV studio. The cross-city live discussion was produced live in both cities as a hybrid event and broadcast as a live stream.

We impart the 4.0 know-how

Digitalization consists of horizontal cross-cutting topics. Unlike many other networks, we at Hamburg@work therefore <u>do not</u> organize ourselves according to vertical sectors, but instead distinguish between five overarching key topics:

The new **technologies**, including the digital infrastructure and its many possibilities, provide us with the basis for this. Cyber security, software engineering, big data and cloud computing are already among the key technologies. And trends such as artificial intelligence, robotics, emotion AI and digital twins are moving ever closer to our everyday lives. Anyone who wants to help shape the digital age will use technology as an enabler for the possibilities of our future.

But only those who help shape change will be able to cope with it. This not only includes topics such as strengthening our digital skills and constantly engaging in critical discourse about the life we want to lead in the future. Digitalization is changing all facets of our **working lives**. Constant innovation and social change are giving rise to





previously unknown professions. The digital nomad of today is nothing more and nothing less than the prime example of the employee of the future. Business processes must be just as agile and flexible as the technologies themselves. Instead of classic clusters, the diagonalization of economic life will shape our actions in the future: Traditional industries will be connected by digital innovations.
